There is no formal assessment on Family Learning courses, but we will help you access the sessions by:

You need to be a parent / grandparent / carer of a child at pre-school children in Coventry. Places are limited and will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis. When the course is full, no other enrolments can take place.
